Call to Order

Carriage Crest 2017–2018 School Improvement Plan

- Robert Gallagher and Danielle DeJong presented a draft of the Carriage Crest 2017–2018 School Improvement Plan (SIP).
- Motto: "Believe, Unite, Inspire."
- Enrollment is up and the school is at 100% capacity (there will be a total of 495 students on Wednesday, November 8th).
- There have been some demographic changes.
- Carriage Crest Elementary is a non-title school. Title schools receive more funding. In order to qualify as a title school, 40% of the students need to be on free/reduced lunches. Only 25% of students are on free/reduced lunches at Carriage Crest Elementary School.
- The school will be focusing on proficiency and growth for every student.
 - Proficiency measures whether a student has met a certain threshold.
 - \circ $\;$ Growth measures how much a student has improved from one test to the next.
- There is a Carriage Crest SIP team that meets one Tuesday afternoon each month. This group includes teachers, staff, and parents.

- The entry line moved slowly
 - The PTSA tried to follow the rule from Washington State PTA training to provide everyone a receipt, later learning that we just needed the ability to provide someone with a receipt.
 - Another card reader is on the way. Card readers are better than typing in a credit card number. It is more costly for the PTSA to type in card numbers.
