Lockdown Drill

• There was a lockdown drill at the school on Thursday, September 14th.

Auction

- Some parents were under the impression that the 2017 auction was done so that there wouldn't be any additional fundraising for two years
 - The auction was held to build up the PTSA funds that were running low. The PTSA did not have any debt, but it helped replenish the accounts.
 - The idea is to hold the auction every other year in order to keep the accounts padded.
 - Approximately \$30,000-\$35,000 was raised from the auction

Parking

- Parking is an issue at the school.
- During Curriculum Night, Amanda worked it out with Mr. Gallagher to open up the gates and have angular parking available for parents and guardians. This is going to be a test run with hopes of being a solution until (or IF) more parking becomes available.
 - Watch D.O.G.S. might be able to help with this
- Mr. Gallagher has refused to make parking available in the back when there are kids running around. This creates safety issues.
- There are also areas where cars cannot be parked because of environmental hazards (e.g., leaking oil from a car might stream into the creek).
- There is street parking in the neighborhood behind the school, but sometimes the gates in the back of the school are closed.
- There was discussion of an elevated sidewalk and a light at the school. The county won't put in a light because of the proximity of the lights at Petrovitsky and 192nd.
- There was bond money for parking, but there is a freeze on spending and that money might end up going to other projects because of the way bonds work.

Fundraising

- Some parents complained about fundraising by selling items (some money goes to the company and some of it goes to the school). Parents are more than welcome to make direct donations.
- More needs to be done to inform parents that their places of employment will match donations.
- Someone suggested setting up a GoFundMe page for supplies. It should be possible, but there are rules that we will need to follow. The PTSA will look into this.
- Someone suggested donations of \$5-\$10 from parents to help fund classroom parties
- You can also use Amazon Prime Smile and Fred Meyer rewards to raise money for the school. Every little bit helps!
